## DEAR FRIENDS,

ten days of Russian war of aggression against Ukraine, thousands dead and about 1.5 million people on the run. The imperial mania leaves us stunned and angry. Completely unpredictable where the escalation of armed violence will lead over the next days and weeks. "No to War. For a Transnational Politics of Peace" is the title of a statement published by the Transnational Social Strike platform at the beginning of March and signed by groups and collectives from many countries:

„We stand together with all those in Ukraine who suffer the outbreak of the war. We stand with all those in Russia who oppose the Putin regime. We back whoever opposes the war from all sides, and we say that all military and economic reciprocal retaliations must stop immediately. The massacre of arms must be stopped as well as a further crisis looming over the life of workers, migrants, women and men that struggle for their daily life. While nationalists preach their actions in the name of identities and in-

terests that fragment and oppress us, and democrats fuel further conflicts in the name of void values that support capital's grip on everyone's life, we call for a transnational politics of all workers, migrants, women and men for peace, against this shattering war.“

As brutal as the war of aggression is and must be stopped immediately, as insane and militaristic are the 100 billion "special funds" for arming the army in Germany. 100 billion that could be used sensibly for climate AND social justice, e.g. to completely phase out fossil fuels.

### **Stop the War - Open the borders!**

Buses that travel to Sicily, Lesbos or the Belorussian border to pick up refugees and bring them to cities of welcome. This idea - new "Buses of Hope" - has been discussed again and again in our networks in recent years, but could not be implemented after 2015. Now, within a few days, they have become a reality.

Quite officially and universally praised, buses from Germany travel to the Ukrainian border to unload aid supplies and they bring refugees with them on the way back. Even the reactionary governments in Poland or Hungary have agreed to the new "EU mass flow directive" and opened their borders. Have to open them! But at least at the Polish border, not equally for everyone. Here, people with passports from African or Asian countries have repeatedly had to wait particularly long when fleeing.

As was said in the mainstream just a few months ago with regard to the Belarusian border: just no new 2015. What was meant was - as in 2015 on the Balkan route - open borders, even if in autumn 2021 only a few thousand people were at stake. Instead, refugees were blocked with barbed wire at the Polish border and left to freeze to death in forests as a deterrent. The sentence could now be turned around: just no new 2016! Against a renewed racist roll-

back, against border closures with new walls and against mass deportations. For open borders, for everyone.

In addition, a look in the opposite direction: at the EU south-western border in Melilla! "Big Boza" on two consecutive days. Several thousand migrants collectively stormed the fences at the beginning of March. The majority were detained or pushed back. But several hundred people made it across this highly armed EU border.

### **STOP THE WAR - OPEN THE BORDERS!**

#### **Transnational Social Strike:**

##### **No to War. For a Transnational Politics of Peace**

„Russian large-scale attack over Ukraine brings war among us.

In these weeks we saw the escalation of tensions between world powers under the astonished eyes of those who are struggling to recover their lives from two years of pandemic. We have seen relatives and friends die for Covid and suffer for something that has changed lives for all. When we hoped the pandemic sorrow was about to be over, another war reminds us of the urgent need to collectively fight for a different politics. Public discourse seems to force us to take sides: either with Russian imperialism or with NATO expansionism and the prominent role of the US. We are supposed to take a side with one nationalism or with the other. But both systems organise exploitation with different means and turn borders into deadly tools. It is not by chance that the remilitarisation of borders has happened first against migrants seeking a better life. It is not by chance that no declarations from all sides are currently concerned with people's actual lives....

#### **Declaration of Afrique-Europe-Interact**

##### **For the reception of all war refugees from Ukraine!**

##### **No to racist exclusion!**

We welcome the fact that the EU states invoked the Temporary Protection Directive on 3 March 2022 and thus cleared the way for a quick and uncomplicated reception of war refugees from Ukraine. People fleeing the war will receive a temporary protection status, which can be extended by decision of the interior ministers, and which they do not have to prove in an individual procedure, unlike asylum applications. The Temporary Protection Directive also guarantees minimum standards for war refugees, such as the right to take up work, access to social systems and access to education.

At the same time, we protest in the strongest terms against the fact that this step towards rapid and uncomplicated reception does not include all people fleeing the war in Ukraine, but is once again riddled with racist exclusions:

According to the current decision of the EU states, only Ukrainian citizens, as well as people who had a recognized national or international protection status in Ukraine, such as recognized asylum seekers, have a binding right to reception in the EU states in accordance with the Temporary Protection Directive.

However, other citizens of so-called 'third countries' who have lived in Ukraine for a short or long period of time, such as foreign students, migrant workers or people without asylum recognition, are excluded from a binding right to reception in the EU states. For the-



se people, the individual EU states themselves can decide to admit them according to the Temporary Protection Directive, but they can also refuse to receive them.

However, other citizens of so-called 'third countries' who have lived in Ukraine for a short or long period of time, such as foreign students, migrant workers or people without asylum recognition, are excluded from a binding right to reception in the EU states. For these people, the individual EU states themselves can decide to admit them according to the Temporary Protection Directive, but they can also refuse to receive them.

Affected by this exclusion are, among others, a considerable number of students from African countries, including Nigeria, Algeria, Ghana, Guinean Cameroon and Ivory Coast, who were studying medicine until the outbreak of the war in Ukraine.

From the beginning this exclusion was accompanied by racist harassment by Ukrainian and Polish security forces who prevented African persons as well as other refugees from boarding trains or from entering Poland. In the Polish city of Przemysl, there have been violent attacks by Nazi gangs on non-white war refugees. In recent days, politicians from various EU countries have repeatedly emphasized in their speeches the difference between Ukrainian refugees who would belong "to the European family" and the many thousands of other refugees who for years have made their way to Europe from many parts of the world fleeing war, persecution and unbearable living conditions.

Against the racist rhetoric of division and the racist practice of exclusion in the decisions of the EU states, we demand:

The rapid and uncomplicated reception of war refugees from Ukraine through the European Temporary Protection Directive must be extended immediately and bindingly for all EU states to all people fleeing the war in Ukraine – without any distinction based on nationality, origin, residence title or skin color.

As long as there is no binding extension of the Temporary Protection Directive to all war refugees from Ukraine at the EU level, individual member states themselves must apply the Temporary Protection Directive so that it applies indiscriminately to all people fleeing Ukraine.

Fleeing people who have studied in Ukraine must be admitted to universities in the countries where they flee to continue their studies, regardless of nationality or origin.

We demand a fundamental departure from the EU policy of closed borders, murderous border regime and externalization of European borders.

Safe travel routes, open borders and reception for all migrants and people seeking protection!

Solidarity-based practice against the consequences of the war in Ukraine must also include: Practical measures against serious and existence-threatening consequences of the war also on people in the Global South. Countries in North Africa, or even countries like Kenya or Cameroon, have so far covered a large part of their grain needs with wheat supplies from Ukraine and Russia. Their supply situation is now acutely threatened. In other African countries, too, the impact of the war on the world market is threatening food security. We must prevent the war in Europe from plunging the populations of African countries into a hunger crisis!

We welcome the fact that people in various European countries – in Poland, in Germany, in France, in Austria and elsewhere – are showing practical solidarity these days with war



refugees from Ukraine on the move. We call for this practical solidarity to be extended to all who are fleeing and to actively undermine the politics of racist division!

### **March 8th: Strike the War!**

by E.A.S.T. (Essential Autonomous Struggles Transnational)



Stop the war in Ukraine! On 8M we call for a transnational feminist strike against war!

We are outraged by the brutal aggression that Putin and his imperialist war brought to Ukraine. We know that neither the people in Ukraine nor in Russia want this

war – it is favoured only by the ruling elites and the capitalist classes, profiting from it! We stand together with all those opposing Putin's invasion and with those rising up against war around the world!

War is the most brutal form of patriarchal violence. It radically reinforces the idea that men should take up arms and participate in killings, beatings, rapes and other violent actions in the name of the "fatherland". War is always waged at the expense of those who have no alternatives and cannot flee to safe places. Women, the LGBTQI+ community, Roma people, workers and migrants in Ukraine are the ones already suffering the direct consequences of this militaristic invasion. The war in Ukraine is a brutal acceleration of all other crises that hit people in Eastern and Central Europe and elsewhere: from the pandemic to the collapse of the whole (health)care sector, from the increase of reproductive work mostly performed by women to the rise of domestic violence. We demand an immediate ceasefire and a retreat of Russian military forces from Ukraine!

War intensifies to the extreme nationalistic logics and actions. It forces the working classes and the poor in one country to fight against and kill the working classes, the poor and vulnerable in another country. We draw attention to the duty of NATO states – as military powers with destructive potential and as responsible actors in tensions around the world – to refrain from and de-escalate military confrontations. We call for disarmament and for the reduction of public budgets allocated to military spending. We call for the use of such budgets for essential public services such as (health)care, housing and basic utilities for all.

War escalates racist violence. We already see how while Poland, Hungary, Romania and Bulgaria have pledged to host Ukrainian refugees, non-EU migrants based in Ukraine and trying to leave the country are stuck at the borders or attacked by nationalists on the other side, and the general policy of pushbacks and border violence in Europe continues. We demand open borders for everyone who is fleeing war or is looking for a better life elsewhere!



The outbreak of the war shows in the most extreme way that, once again, as our work is essential but devalued and exploited, our lives remain disposable.

As EAST we call women, LGBTQI+ people, workers, migrants in Eastern and Central Europe, bordering countries and beyond and all those who refuse this war to form a strong opposition to any false alternative between violent geopolitical projects and to any further militar buildup. We won't let this war divide us!

Against all nationalisms, against all international power games, we strike the war and all neoliberal, racist and patriarchal violence. Against any retreat in national dynamics, only a strong transnational feminist strike can be the proper response. On March 8th we will strike the war which is the most revolting form of violence. On March 8th we call everyone for a transnational feminist strike against war!

On March 8th we strike: Stop war now! Our lives are essential!


### **ALARM PHONE: CENTRAL MED ANALYSIS**

#### **MIGRANT RESISTANCE AGAINST YET ANOTHER NEW LEVEL OF BRUTALITY**

„In the second half of 2021, Alarm Phone was alerted to 214 boats in the central Mediterranean region. Together with the 193 boats that Alarm Phone had supported in the first half of the year, in 2021 we assisted a total of 407 boats in distress in the central Mediterranean only. This is by far the highest number of distress cases reported to us in this



region within a year. In 2019, Alarm Phone had assisted 101 cases. In 2020, we supported 173 distressed boats. This considerable increase in distress cases reflects both a significant increase of precarious crossings over the past years, as well as a greater knowledge of the Alarm Phone network among migrant communities.

Of the 407 boats we supported in 2021, 45 boats were rescued to Europe by the civil Search and Rescue fleet. Despite obstruction and harassment by state authorities, these civil rescuers have returned to sea, again and again, to carry out life-saving missions. As state authorities in both Europe and northern Africa often fail to inform of rescues or interceptions, we do not know exactly how many of the other boats that called Alarm Phone

reached Europe or were returned to Libya or Tunisia. However, in the monthly breakdown below, we provide further information on how many boats we believe have arrived in Europe or were returned to northern Africa.

In 2021, Alarm Phone also had to witness the shipwrecks of several boats that reached out to us, with hundreds of people losing their lives. While official statistics speak of about 1550 deaths in the central Mediterranean Sea in 2021, we know that this is a significant undercount, as many shipwrecks reported to us by friends or families of the missing were never officially accounted for. We will never know how many lives were lost at sea in 2021. We only know that they are always too many.

Over the year, we had to also witness how groups of people escaping Libya and Tunisia were systematically abducted at sea and forced back into conditions where their human rights are severely violated. More than 32,400 people were intercepted by the EU-funded so-called Libyan coastguard – the number almost tripled compared to 2020. EU authorities have not merely funded, trained, and politically legitimised the Libyan forces, they also continue to cooperate closely with them to organise boat interceptions and re-foulements. While EU authorities fail to adequately coordinate Search and Rescue operations to Europe, routinely engaging in acts of non-assistance and push-back, they are also actively supporting the mass interceptions by Libyan and Tunisian authorities, not least through aerial surveillance operations. Since 2021 a Frontex drone has been active above the Central Mediterranean sea, in addition to several airplanes spotting migrant boats heading to Europe, reporting them to Libyan authorities, and facilitating their pushbacks.



Despite high level of push backs to the places of departure, the countless violations of human rights in detention, violence and exploitation, people on the move keep searching and finding ways to flee Libya, Tunisia, Turkey or Greece to European shores.

Resistance against the constant violence and rising surveillance against people on the move does not only lead to find alternative paths to Europe, by changing routes or by travelling on different kind of boats, but also culminated in collective self-organisation by refugees in Libya who, since October 2021, have organised powerful protests in front of the UNHCR in Tripoli.

In this report, we provide an overview of several acts of resistance and we offer a chronology of events that occurred in the second half of 2021. We do so to create an archive of the struggles that have occurred in the central Mediterranean Sea, which are often ignored or silenced by state authorities. Besides the stubborn and continuous struggles of people on the move, we have seen how the civil fleet, together with airborne divisions of NGOs and the Alarm Phone, have shed light on developments that EU authorities do not want the public to see. By writing down this chronology, we add to our growing archive of the struggles at sea and the resistance to the violent EU border regime both by people on the move and by those who support them..."

### **PRO ASYL ON MURDEROUS PUSH-BACKS IN THE AEGEAN SEA**

Deaths at the EU's external border with Greece. PRO ASYL demands an international investigation, comprehensive clarification and victim protection.

19 dead refugees in the Greek-Turkish border area at the beginning of February 2022 - and now a shocking media report about the Greek coast guard throwing asylum seekers overboard into the open sea. Two men died, reports the research network of Spiegel, Guardian and others. PRO ASYL demands both international investigations and comprehensive clarification as well as infringement proceedings against Greece, which the EU Commission must initiate. The situation in Greece is characterised by systematic pushbacks, deaths and a crisis of the rule of law. The death of these two asylum seekers is unfortunately not an isolated case. It is one case in a chain of systematic pushbacks by the Greek border authorities. The human rights organisation PRO ASYL and its Greek partners have been documenting these inhumane practices for years. And they support the complaints of the victims before the European Court of Human Rights (ECtHR). For example, in 2014, a fishing boat with 27 refugees in tow sank off the island of Farmakonisi and eleven people died. The case before the ECtHR is still pending...."

### IUVENTA TRIAL IN SIZILY IN MAY 2022



„...The first hearing in our case will take place in Trapani, Sicily, at the beginning of May 2022.

After almost five years of the seizure of the Iuventa, four years after the announcement of the investigation and one year after the announcement that they are officially pressing charges, the long time we have been



waiting and hanging in the air, during which they have let the luventa rust to rubbish and, above all, let thousands of people drown in the Mediterranean, has come to an end and the moment for us to fight this battle in court has indeed arrived and is fast approaching. For this we need you and your support more than ever!

We probably don't need to repeat it, but this trial is not only or even primarily about the freedom of the four of us (or that of the defendants from Médecins Sans Frontières and Save the Children), but it is a political stage where nothing less than the right to sea rescue, the right to freedom of movement and the right to life are being negotiated. Much more than a legal battle for us individuals, it is a political battle against the war that the European Union is waging against people on the move - a war that concerns us all. We want to fight it in the best way possible!"

### **TRANSBORDER SUMMER CAMP IN JULY 2022**
